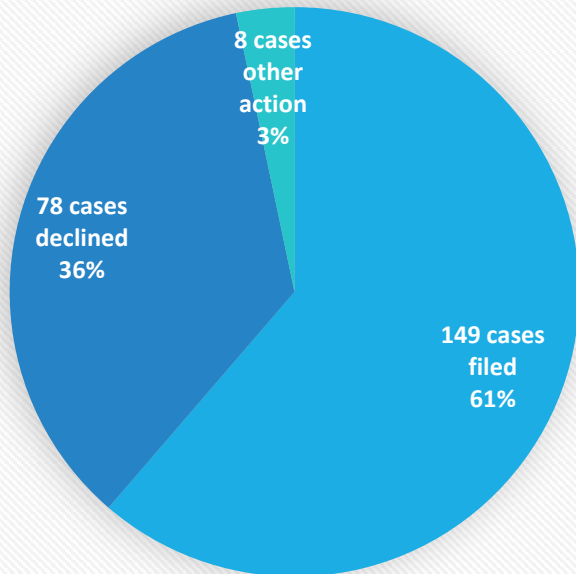

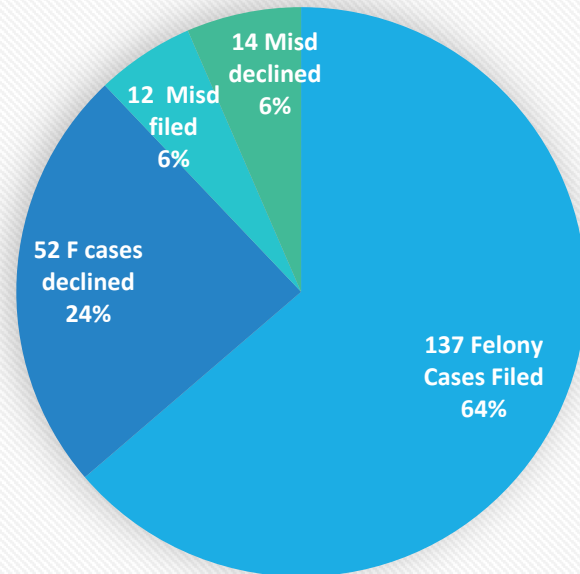

Cases Presented (235)

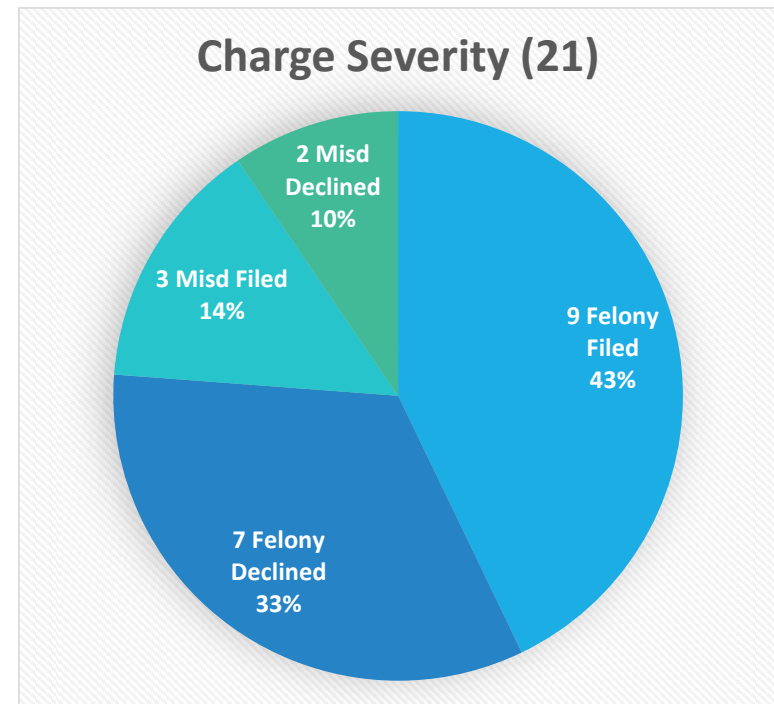
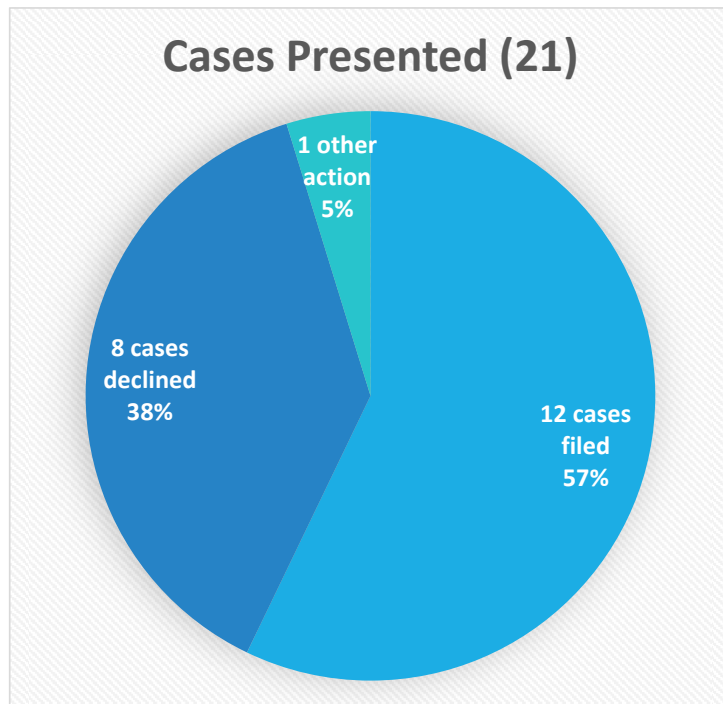


Charge Severity (235)

Current Pending HC Cases

41 total cases (35 felony, 6 misdemeanor)

- 7 based on sexual orientation
- 6 based on religion
- 3 based on gender
- 25 based on race
 - 13 – Asian
 - 11 – Black
 - 1 – Latino

WHAT ACT IS A HATE CRIME? 什麼是仇恨犯罪?

Any criminal act, all of it or only a part, committed because of your protected status. 任何針對你受保護身份而發生的罪行

(Cal. Penal Code 加州刑法 5 422.55)

WHO IS PROTECTED? 誰受到保護?

- Disabled 殘障人士**
physical, mental, or combination 身體或心理殘障
- Gender 性別**
female, male, transgender, non-binary, etc. 女、男、變性人、非二元等。
- Nationality 國籍**
country of origin (i.e. Chinese, Italian, etc.) 祖國 (例如中國人、意大利人等)
- Race or Ethnicity 種族或族裔**
Asian, African-American, Latina/o, etc. 亞裔、非裔美國人、拉丁裔等
- Religion 宗教**
Islam, Judaism, Christianity, Hinduism, Buddhism, etc. 伊斯蘭教、猶太教、基督教、印度教、佛教等
- Sexual Orientation 性取向**
Lesbian, Gay, Bi-sexual, Queer, etc. 同性戀、雙性戀、酷兒等
- Associated with any of the above 與上述有任何關聯**



IF YOU, OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW ARE A HATE CRIME VICTIM 如果你或你認識的某個人是仇恨犯罪的受害者

- Contact police or dial 9-1-1 立即聯繫當地執法部門
- Detail what happened (when, where, what, why, who) What exactly was the hate language? Use same words. Write it down. 詳盡記錄發生經過，寫下事件上所出現過的仇視語言和詞語
- Detail suspect and witnesses- the who: Known (contact info?) or unknown. What did they look like (i.e. gender, race, height, clothes, identifying tattoos/piercings, etc.) 詳細記下嫌犯和證人：是你認識的嗎？性別，種族，身高，衣服，刺青紋身和耳洞等
- Save evidence (photos, videos, writings, emails/letters, etc.) Take screenshots of texts or social media 保存證據 (照片、視頻、電子郵件/信件等) 短信或社交媒體等的屏幕截圖
- Provide best contact information or alternative contact info 提供最佳聯繫方式或替代方式
- Obtain a copy of the Emergency Protective Order (if issued) 如有的話，索取一份緊急保護令的副本
- Obtain Police Report / CAD Number for your records 索取警察報告或案件號碼作為記錄
