

1 [Grant funds to support comprehensive drug court implementation.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$287,177 from the California**
5 **Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (DADP) to plan and implement a**
6 **dependency drug court that works across city departments; for the period of July 1,**
7 **2007 to December 31, 2007.**

9 WHEREAS, DADP increased by \$287,177 and extended the timeline for six months of
10 an existing grant to establish and maintain a drug court in SF Dependency Court; and,

11 WHEREAS, This is a joint project of DPH, the Superior Court of San Francisco and the
12 Child Welfare Service of the San Francisco Human Services Agency; and,

13 WHEREAS, DADP requires that the funds be administered by the San Francisco
14 County Alcohol and Drug Program Administrator, which is located within DPH; and,

15 WHEREAS, The entire amount will be used to award contracts on the basis of recent
16 RFPs Family and Perinatal Substance Abuse Treatment, and a sole source contract with
17 Superior Court for a Dependency Drug Court Coordinator and related new court costs; and,

18 WHEREAS, DPH anticipates \$287,177 to also be awarded in future years on the
19 calendar year to maintain the program; and

20 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, DADP requires the City to
21 comply with the terms of an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the
22 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to
23 be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

24 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment because staffing costs are
25 not included in the budget; and,

1 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
2 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a
4 grant in the amount of \$287,177 from DADP; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
6 indirect costs in the grant budget, and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and
8 expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement,
9 pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.170-1.
