

1 [Bicyclist Injury Reporting Hot Line]

2 URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO ESTABLISH AND PROVIDE
3 PUBLIC NOTICE OF A BICYCLIST INJURY REPORTING HOT LINE WHICH WOULD BE
4 AVAILABLE FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST NINE MONTHS BEGINNING ON NOVEMBER
5 1998.

6 WHEREAS, The City wishes to promote bicycle safety and encourage
7 bicycle commuting as an alternative mode of travel to help reduce
8 traffic congestion in the City; and

9 WHEREAS, A bicyclist injury reporting hot line would provide
10 citizens with a specific place to call when they wish to report
11 bicycle accidents and injuries, including, but not limited to,
12 injuries involving other vehicles or bicycles or injuries resulting
13 from conditions on the streets or sidewalks; and

14 WHEREAS, A bicyclist injury reporting hot line would enable the
15 City to maintain a centralized reporting and record-keeping system
16 regarding a broad variety of types and locations of bicyclist
17 injuries in the City; and

18 WHEREAS, The data collected from reports made to the bicyclist
19 injury reporting hot line could serve as a resource for evaluating
20 and ultimately rectifying unsafe conditions or locations throughout
21 the City; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of
23 Parking and Traffic to establish and provide public notice of a
24 bicyclist injury reporting hot line which would be available for a
25 period of at least nine months beginning on November
1998.




