3 **Motion authorizing preparation of written Opponent ballot arguments and rebuttal**
4 **ballot arguments for submittal to the voters at the June 5, 2012, Consolidated**
5 **Presidential Primary Election.**
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7 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors wishes to authorize the Board Member(s)
8 opposed to the following ballot measures to prepare and submit a written opponent ballot
9 argument and rebuttal ballot argument for submittal to the Director of Elections:
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- 12 • Garbage Collection and Disposal – Ordinance requiring the City to use a competitive
13 bidding process to award five separate agreements for trash and recycling services,
14 require that processing and transfer facilities be owned by the City and located in San
15 Francisco, require the Board of Supervisors to approve maximum rates for garbage
16 services, and allow the Board of Supervisors to make future amendments that advance
17 the purposes of this ordinance without further voter approval. (Supervisor Wiener)
 - 18 • Coit Tower – Declaration of Policy to strictly limit commercial activities and private
19 events at Coit Tower and to use funds received by the City from Coit Tower concession
20 operations on the Coit Tower murals, building, and Pioneer Park. (Supervisor Elsbernd)
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22 WHEREAS, The Board Member(s) authorized to submit the opponent ballot
23 arguments, will submit the argument to the Director of Elections no later than the deadline of
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1 noon, March 15, 2012, and the respective rebuttal ballot argument no later than noon, March
2 19, 2012; now, therefore, be it

3 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Board Member(s) and/or
4 sponsor(s) and designated opponent(s) of each measure, as listed above, under the
5 provisions of the San Francisco Elections Code Sections 530 and 550, to prepare and submit
6 a written opponent ballot argument and respective rebuttal ballot arguments on their
7 measures; and, be it

8 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board Member(s) and/or sponsor(s) and opponent(s) of
9 measures submitted to the voters for the June 5, 2012, Presidential Primary Election, who are
10 authorized by this motion to prepare and submit arguments, may authorize or assign to any
11 other person(s) under the provisions of the San Francisco Elections Code Sections 530 and
12 550 (c) and (d) the right to prepare and submit the proponent or opponent's ballot arguments
13 and/or respective rebuttal arguments.

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
