

1 [Contract funds from a new primary contractor to evaluate the impact of a resource center for
2 drug users, Year 3.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Community**
5 **Behavioral Health Services (SFPDH,CBHS), to enter retroactively into Year 3 of an**
6 **agreement with a new primary contractor, the Research Triangle Institute (RTI), and**
7 **expend funds in the amount of \$6,004 to provide research evaluation services; for the**
8 **period of July 1, 2005 to December 31, 2005.**

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10 WHEREAS, RTI is the recipient of a grant award from the Department of Health and
11 Human Services, National Institutes of Health, for Year 3 of a program titled, Evaluating
12 Impact of a Resource Center for Drug Users; and,

13 WHEREAS, RTI, and SFPDH,CBHS have agreed to enter into a subcontract
14 agreement to participate in this project; and,

15 WHEREAS, RTI has agreed to reimburse SFPDH,CBHS in the amount of \$6,004 from
16 this award under the terms for Year 3 of this subcontract agreement; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, RTI requires SFPDH,CBHS to enter
18 into an agreement (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
19 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
20 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

21 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$141; and,

22 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
23 because we did not receive the new subcontract agreement until late in September, 2005;
24 and,

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1 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
2 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
3 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
4 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That SFDPH,CBHS is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a Year
6 3 subcontract agreement in the amount of \$6,004 with RTI, the primary contractor; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
8 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded
10 under this agreement as a “G” or grant-funded position which would terminate when the
11 agreement expires.
