[Legislative Analyst Report on Transit-First Policy] ASKING OUR LEGISLATIVE ANALYST TO RESEARCH THE DEFINITION AND APPLICATIONS TO DATE OF SAN FRANCISO'S TRANSIT-FIRST POLICY

WHEREAS; San Francisco's density and geographic constraints make it impossible to rely upon the private automobile to efficiently and safely move people and goods; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors recognized the economic importance of this fact, and the fundamentalness of public transportation in addressing it by passing the Transit-First Policy in 1973, incorporated in Section 16.102 of the City Charter; and,

WHEREAS, The Transit-First Policy was strengthened in the new City Charter in 1996 with the addition of language mandating its consideration by all officers, commission, and departments in conducting the City's affairs; and.

WHEREAS, A well-functioning public transportation system remains increasingly crucial to the economic and environmental health of San Francisco, especially in light of planned developments, including Yerba Buena Center, the Giants Stadium, the Mission Bay campus, and expansion of the Airport; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco's public transportation system has greatly suffered from a lack of institutional-accountability, capacity, and financial stability over the past decade; and,

WHEREAS, The need to review our Transit-First Policy, its application to date, and to assess any needed revisions and enchancements is paramount; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has directed the Legislative Analyst to report on the merger of the Parking and Traffic Commission with the Public Transportation Commission as a first step in more aggressively evaluating Transit-First; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby ask our Legislative Analyst to research the definition and applications to date of the Transit-First Policy.
