

1 [Inform low-income women about availability of Medi-Cal coverage for a pregnancy test and  
2 outpatient prenatal care.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**  
5 **accept retroactively and expend a new grant in the amount of \$25,000 from the March**  
6 **of Dimes to inform low-income women about Medi-Cal coverage for pregnancy testing**  
7 **and outpatient prenatal care and to enter into an agreement which includes an**  
8 **indemnification clause for the use of these funds; for the period of January 1, 2003**  
9 **through December 31, 2003.**

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11 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from the March of  
12 Dimes in the amount of \$25,000 to inform low-income women in San Francisco about a  
13 temporary, “bridging” Medi-Cal that covers a pregnancy test and outpatient prenatal care; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the March of Dimes requires  
15 the City to comply with the terms of an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file  
16 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby  
17 declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,  
19 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend a  
21 grant in the amount of \$25,000 from the March of Dimes; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
23 indirect costs in the budget of the Agreement; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision  
25 in the Agreement pursuant to which the City indemnifies the March of Dimes; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
2 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded  
4 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the  
5 agreement expires.
