Proposed Amendment/Agreement Details

• Resolution: Approve the third amendment to the agreement between HSH and Episcopal Community Services (ECS) for Adult Rapid Rehousing (RRH).

∽Term:

- Current Term: February 15, 2021 January 31, 2025
- Amended Term: February 15, 2021 June 30, 2027

•Amount: Increases not-to-exceed amount by \$11,525,980 for a total notto-exceed amount of \$21,524,980.

←Commission approval: December 5, 2024



Grant Agreement Overview

- Episcopal Community Services provides housing location and coordination, landlord liaison, and subsidy administration services.
- Primary Objective: Empower clients to gradually assume 100 percent responsibility of their monthly rent and housing stability through financial support and wrap around services.
- Subsidies are one-time and for **12 to 24 months**.


Rapid Rehousing Slots

- The current agreement serves up to **230 adults.**
- By October 2024, ECS had used ~90% of those slots.
- The Amended Agreement will expand total slots to a maximum of **305 adults**.



Program Context

- •As of October 2024, ECS provided:
 - Housing location services to 207 adults
 - Housing-focused case management to **117 adults**
- ECS partners with Bayview
 Hunters Point Foundation and Five Keys to provide housing-focused case management for up to 100 clients.
- ECS partners with private-market landlords throughout the Bay Area to ensure rapid placement.
- 100% funded through Prop C Our City, Our Home dollars
