

1 [Endorsement of BASOC as San Francisco Bid Committee]
2 AUTHORIZING THE BAY AREA SPORTS ORGANIZING COMMITTEE TO REPRESENT
3 THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AS THE OFFICIAL BID COMMITTEE IN
4 SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES OLYMPIC COMMITTEE TO
5 HOST THE GAMES OF THE XXX OLYMPIAD IN 2012

7 WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Olympic Charter, the United States Olympic Committee
8 (USOC) will administer the bid process whereby US cities will compete to be selected as the
9 city representing the United States (the Candidate City) in the international competition to be
10 selected by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) to host the Games of the XXX
11 Olympiad in 2012; and,

12 WHEREAS, On May 1, 1997, the Mayor of San Francisco submitted to the USOC a
13 Letter of Intent to Bid (LOI) expressing the City's intent to compete in the selection of a US
14 Candidate City for the Games of the XXX Olympiad in 2012; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Mayor of San Francisco sought the assistance of the San Francisco
16 Bay Area Sports Organizing Committee (BASOC), to raise and deliver to the USOC the
17 required bid deposit of \$100,000; and,

18 WHEREAS, On November 5, 1997, the USOC delivered to the City a Bid City
19 Recognition Letter confirming the USOC's acceptance of the LOI and the bid deposit and the
20 USOC's recognition of San Francisco's eligibility to compete for selection as the Candidate
21 City; and,

22 WHEREAS, the USOC requires that bid cities form a non-profit bid committee to
23 pursue a bid on behalf of the bid city; and,

24 WHEREAS, BASOC is a non-profit corporation which satisfies all USOC requirements
25 to serve as a bid committee and is comprised of Bay Area civic, corporate, and athletic

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1 leaders who have pledged to work towards developing a bid for the City and County of San
2 Francisco in its effort to be selected as the Candidate City by the USOC; and,

3 WHEREAS, the USOC requires Bid Committees to submit a Bid Committee
4 Agreement acknowledging the USOC's terms and conditions under which bid committees and
5 cities shall compete for selection as the city representing the United States in the international
6 competition to host the Olympic Games; and,

7 WHEREAS, the USOC requires that the legislative body of each bid city endorse their
8 bid committee, authorize the bid committee to pursue the bid on the city's behalf and enter
9 into all necessary agreements, and acknowledge the USOC's requirements for bid city
10 participation in the bid process; and,

11 WHEREAS, The formal bid to host the Games of the XXX Olympiad in 2012 is due by
12 March 31, 2000; and

13 WHEREAS, If the City elects to submit a bid, it will involve further legislative action
14 approving the bid submission to meet the USOC's expectations and requirements regarding
15 the City's contribution of resources to host the Games; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors endorses BASOC to serve
17 as the official Bid Committee; and be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes BASOC to pursue,
19 on the City's behalf, the bid for the USOC's selection of a Candidate City for the Games of the
20 XXX Olympiad in 2012.


