7 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the
8 Immigrant Rights Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 211-97, for the
9 term specified:

10 Richard Ow, succeeding Emi Gusukuma, term expired, seat 6, must be an
11 immigrant to the United States who is appointed in accordance with Section 4.101 of the
12 Charter. In addition, members shall have a demonstrated knowledge of and interest in the
13 health, human service, educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in
14 San Francisco, for a two-year term ending June 6, 2005.

15 Jose Ricardo Bondoc, succeeding Joseph Nwadibia, term expired, seat 10, must be an
16 immigrant to the United States who is appointed in accordance with Section 4.101 of the
17 Charter. In addition, members shall have a demonstrated knowledge of and interest in the
18 health, human service, educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in
19 San Francisco, for a two-year term ending June 6, 2005.


