

1 [Grant to fund a study through the HIV Prevention Section, Department of Public Health.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to accept**  
4 **and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$12,680 from the Public Health**  
5 **Foundation Enterprises (PHFE), the primary contractor, with funds from the National**  
6 **Institutes of Health, to support a study entitled “Aripiprazole Treatment for**  
7 **Methamphetamine Using MSM;” for the period of August 1, 2007 through July 31, 2008.**

9 WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institutes of  
10 Health (NIH), for a project titled “Aripiprazole Treatment for Methamphetamine Using MSM;”  
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interest of NIH, PHFE, and DPH to participate  
13 in this project; and,

14 WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse DPH in the amount of \$12,680 under the  
15 terms of this agreement for the period of August 1, 2007 through July 31, 2008; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds PHFE requires DPH to enter into an  
17 agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
18 Supervisors in File No. 090902, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if  
19 set forth fully within; and,

20 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses  
21 the department for one existing position, a Senior Physician Specialist (Job Class 2232) at .05  
22 FTE for the period of August 1, 2007 through July 31, 2008; and,

23 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not  
24 receive the required documents from PHFE until May 21, 2008; and,

1 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$2,337; now  
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant  
4 in the amount of \$12,680 with PHFE, the primary contractor, for services under the project  
5 entitled "Aripiprazole Treatment for Methamphetamine Using MSM;" and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
7 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,  
8 be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
10 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions  
12 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when  
13 the agreement expires.
