

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - Centers for Disease Control and Prevention -
2 National Human Immunodeficiency Virus Behavioral Surveillance (NHBS) - San Francisco -
3 \$2,223,299]

4 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
5 **expend a grant increase in the amount of up to \$1,254,056 from the Centers for Disease**
6 **Control and Prevention for a total amount of \$2,223,299 for participation in a program,**
7 **entitled “National Human Immunodeficiency Virus Behavioral Surveillance (NHBS) -**
8 **San Francisco,” for the period of January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023.**

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10 WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has agreed to
11 fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$2,223,299 for participation in a
12 program, entitled “National Human Immunodeficiency Virus Behavioral Surveillance (NHBS)
13 San Francisco,” for the period of January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2023; and

14 WHEREAS, The purpose of NHBS in San Francisco is to conduct bio-behavioral
15 surveillance activities among populations overburdened by Human Immunodeficiency Virus
16 (HIV); and

17 WHEREAS, NHBS will estimate levels, and monitor changes over time in HIV
18 prevalence and related risk and preventive behaviors; and

19 WHEREAS, The short-term aims are to collect and use data to measure prevention,
20 testing, and treatment program reach; guide the development and strengthening of these
21 efforts; evaluate prevention activities; and inform prevention policy; and

22 WHEREAS, Long-term use of NHBS data will improve prevention, care, and treatment
23 services to reduce the burden and incidence of HIV; and

24 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and
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1 WHEREAS, A grant increase of \$1,254,056 from \$969,243 was approved for the
2 period of January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023; and

3 WHEREAS, Part of the grant increase in the amount of \$800,000 is contingent on the
4 enactment of application appropriation bills by the federal government, and the availability of
5 funds; and

6 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought for the grant increase of
7 \$1,254,056, because DPH received the award notice on December 5, 2022, for a project start
8 date of January 1, 2023; and

9 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
10 \$22,512; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
12 in the amount of \$2,223,299 from the CDC; and, be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
14 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1.
