1 [Contract Prop J: Facility Security Services]

2 RETROACTIVELY
3 **CONCURRING WITH THE CONTROLLER'S CERTIFICATION THAT FACILITY SECURITY**
4 **SERVICES FOR THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION CAN BE PRACTICALLY**
5 **PERFORMED BY A PRIVATE CONTRACTOR AT A LOWER COST THAN BY CITY AND**
6 **COUNTY EMPLOYEES.**

7 **WHEREAS**, Section 10.104.15 of the San Francisco Charter allows Departments to contract for
8 services when it has been determined by the Controller and approved by a resolution of the Board of
9 Supervisors to be more economical; and

10 **WHEREAS**, The Public Transportation Commission desires to continue providing comprehensive
11 facility security services to protect its employees and assets through a private security contractor; and

12 **WHEREAS**, The private security contractor selected by the Public Transportation Commission, King
13 Security Services, Inc., has performed competently and has reduced acts of graffiti vandalism from 1,212 in
14 1997 to 426 in 1998; and

15 **WHEREAS**, The Office of the Controller has determined that contracting for facility security services
16 with a private contractor is more economical than providing the same services with City and County
17 employees; now therefore be it

18 retroactively
19 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with the Controller's determination that facility
20 security services for the Public Transportation Commission can be practically performed by a private
21 contractor at a lower cost than by City and County employees for the period of fiscal year 1998-99.


