WHEREAS, The private security contractor selected by the Public Transportation Commission, King Security Services, Inc., has performed competently and has reduced acts of graffiti vandalism from 1,212 in 1997 to 426 in 1998; and

WHEREAS, The Office of the Controller has determined that contracting for facility security services with a private contractor is more economical than providing the same services with City and County employees; now therefore be it
