

Long Range Planning Process


The **San Francisco Transportation Plan (SFTP)** is San Francisco's countywide 30-year blueprint for transportation system development & investments.

- Integrates all modes and operators serving SF
- Identifies infrastructure priorities for state and federal funding, e.g.:
 - 3rd Street / Central Subway LRT
 - Caltrain Electrification
 - The Portal



SF's Transit Network Strategy

- SFCTA's 4 Corridors Plan (1995) identified a potential Central Subway extension to the north
- SF's Transit Strategy (2021) identified the next generation of major transit projects, with Central Subway extension among 5 citywide rail expansion priorities
- These 5 projects range in level of planning & development to date



Goals and Measuring Performance

Federal Criteria (FTA Capital Investment Grant Program)

- **Project Justification:** mobility, environmental, and congestion benefits; land use and economic development
- **Local Financial Commitment:** ability to build/operate; local match commitment


