WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Public Works has found and declared an emergency pursuant to Section 6.30 of the San Francisco Administrative Code with regard to the dangerous condition; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with and supports the Director of the Department of Public Works' finding and declaration of an emergency relating to the dangerous condition at Ocean Beach along the Great Highway; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That The Board of Supervisors urges the Director of the Department of Public Works to take all necessary emergency measures in the most expeditious manner to protect the public safety, health, welfare, and property of the citizens of
