3 PUBLIC WORKS' FINDING AND DECLARATION OF A PUBLIC EMERGENCY; URGING
4 SAID DIRECTOR TO TAKE NECESSARY MEASURES IN THE MOST EXPEDITIOUS
5 MANNER TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH, WELFARE, AND PROPERTY OF
6 THE CITIZENS OF SAN FRANCISCO WITH REGARD TO THE DANGEROUS CONDITION
7 CREATED BY THE EROSION OF PROTECTIVE SAND DUNES AT OCEAN BEACH ALONG
8 THE GREAT HIGHWAY

9 WHEREAS, An actual emergency exists within the meaning of Section 6.30 of the
10 Administrative Code due to the threat to the health, safety, welfare, and property of citizens
11 caused by heavy rainfall and high tides on March 21, 1999, which eradicated sand dunes at
12 Ocean Beach, posing a significant threat of the collapse of the Great Highway; and,

13 WHEREAS, Rebuilding the sand dunes and/or otherwise stabilizing the dangerous
14 condition is necessary to protect against the threat to the health, safety, welfare and property
15 of citizens; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Public Works has found and declared
17 an emergency pursuant to Section 6.30 of the San Francisco Administrative Code with regard
18 to the dangerous condition; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with and supports the Director of
20 the Department of Public Works' finding and declaration of an emergency relating to the
21 dangerous condition at Ocean Beach along the Great Highway; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That The Board of Supervisors urges the Director of the
23 Department of Public Works to take all necessary emergency measures in the most
24 expeditious manner to protect the public safety, health, welfare, and property of the citizens of


