WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco owns the 900 Innes Property "Property" comprised of Assessor's Parcel Block No. 4646, Lot Nos. 1, 2, 3, 3A, 19, and 20, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 4629A, Lot No. 10, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 4605, Lot Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 24, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 4630, Lot No. 2 and Assessor's Parcel Block No. 4650, Lot No. 2; and

WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Department's (RPD) mission is to provide enriching recreational activities, maintain beautiful parks and preserve the environment for the well-being of everyone in our diverse community; and

WHEREAS, Developing the Property into a public open space supports RPD's mission and is consistent with the Bayview Hunters Point Area Plan, a section of the San Francisco General Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Phase II Environmental Site Investigation conducted during the acquisition process disclosed that there is soil contamination on the property; and

WHEREAS, An Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) prepared for the Property in 2013 provided preliminary information on site remediation options; and WHEREAS, The RPD submitted three grant applications to the United States

Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) Brownfield Cleanup Program to develop a

Remediation Action Plan (RAP) and fund site remediation activities; and

WHEREAS, RPD was awarded two grants for the total amount of \$400,000 to fund the preparation of the RAP and support remediation activities on the property; and

WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission adopted Resolution No. 1607-003 to accept and expend the two US EPA Brownfield Cleanup grants, and authorize staff to seek all necessary reviews and approvals; and

WHEREAS, The terms and conditions of the Grant is detailed in the Agreement on file at the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 161070 which is hereby declared to be part of this resolution as set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The Grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; and

WHEREAS, The Grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs as part of this Grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend two US EPA grants for a combined total of \$400,000 for the development of a remediation action plan and site remediation activities for the 900 Innes Property; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the General Manager, or his or her designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the project.
