12 have a safe place to ask questions and also learn about resources available to young women

15 WHEREAS, This is their 4<sup>th</sup> and most likely final " Proud Young Women's Summit" at  
16 MLK Middle School; and,

17 WHEREAS, For the past four Mayor's summits, MLK ambassadors have been  
18 fortunate to participate through the generous sponsorship of several organizations including  
19 the African American Entrustment and Wells Fargo Bank; and

20 WHEREAS, MLK ambassadors have learned valuable networking skills through  
21 meeting with summit presenters, other participants, and by speaking at press conferences;




