9 WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation, Division of Transportation
10 Planning (DOTP) provides grants to promote Environmental Justice: Context-Sensitive
11 Planning for Communities and,

12 WHEREAS, The Environmental Justice Fund projects are intended to promote public
13 participation and context-sensitive planning to improve mobility, access, equity and quality of
14 life for under-served communities; and

15 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco's Department of Parking and Traffic
16 submitted a proposal for FY 04/05 funding of the Valencia Street Livable Streets Project to
17 produce a comprehensive community-based pedestrian and traffic safety plan for Valencia
18 Street, requesting \$100,359 from the California Department of Transportation's Environmental
19 Justice Planning grant program with a required local match of \$11,151 from Prop K sales tax
20 funding; and,

21 WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation advises the City and County
22 of San Francisco that funding for the Valencia Street Livable Streets Project has been
23 approved; and,


24 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,


1 RESOLVED, That the City and County authorizes the Director of Transportation or his
