14 dedicated to providing tuition reimbursement for library staff pursuing a degree or certification in  
15 Library Science, and

16 WHEREAS, five non-professional employees of San Francisco Public applied to the  
17 California State Library to participate and receive specific tuition reimbursement amounts and  
18 were accepted into the program, and

20 WHEREAS, The California State Library has awarded \$6,795 to San Francisco Public  
21 Library to reimburse the student/employees for Spring and Summer Tuition fees, and

22 WHEREAS, The student employees will provide to San Francisco Public Library  
23 personnel office official transcripts of completion and registration fee receipts as evidence of  
24 completing said classes prior to receiving reimbursements, and


BOARD OF SUPERVISORS




