Supervisors,

I urge you to improve your SB1421 metrics ordinance by:

- 1) adding the Sheriff's Office and District Attorney's Office to section (a) and to the definition of "Department". These agencies are also required to (and do) produce SB1421 records, just as SFPD, DPA, and Police Commission, do.
- 2) adding a 9th piece of information: "*The total number of minutes of audio, video, or audio-video records the Department produced in the reporting period in response to requests for non-confidential peace officer personnel records.*" Bodycam footage and recordings of police interviews and hearings are important parts of police misconduct records that are disclosable under SB1421, but there are currently wide variations between the agencies in their ability and speed of producing such records. (Ex. SFPD regularly produces them, but I believe DPA has not produced any at all yet).
