2 and their families in San Francisco.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
5 **accept retroactively and expend \$50,000 for the first year of a two year grant from the**
6 **California Department of Mental Health (CDMH) to expand the number of mental health**
7 **assessments and other mental health services to children ages 0-5 years and their**
8 **families; for the period of July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2002.**

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10 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant in the amount of
11 \$50,000 for the first year of two years from CDMH to expand the number of mental health
12 assessments and other mental health services to children ages 0-5 and their families; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDMH requires the City to
14 demonstrate satisfactory performance as reflected in the Budget, Narrative, and Work-Plan,
15 copies of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.

16 _____, a copy which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set
17 forth fully herein; and

18 WHEREAS, SFDPH proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program
19 expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend a
21 grant in the amount of \$50,000 for the first year of two years from CDMH pursuant to San
22 Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
24 indirect costs in the grant budget.
