3	Motion ordering submitted to the voters a policy declaration supporting use of
4	proposed Vehicle License Fee increase for transportation infrastructure projects, at an

7	MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby submits the following declaration of
8	policy to the voters of the City and County of San Francisco, at an election to be held on
9	November 8, 2016.

11	Declaration of Policy declaring it official policy of the City and County of San Francisco
12	to use the proceeds of the proposed increase in the Vehicle License Fee on the
13	November 2016 ballot for transportation infrastructure capital to repave deteriorating
14	streets throughout the City and fix potholes throughout the City, to replace and repair
15	old Muni buses and trains, to make Muni less crowded and more reliable, modernize
16	traffic signals throughout the City, and to rebuild streets to make them safer and more
17	accessible for everyone, including those who drive, walk, bicycle, and take transit.
18	The People of the City and County of San Francisco declare that:
19	1. It shall be the official policy of the City and County of San Francisco that the
20	proceeds of the proposed increase in the Vehicle License Fee (VLF) on the November 2016
21	ballot be used to support these transportation improvements:
22	<ul> <li>Improving the condition of San Francisco's roads by repaving deteriorating</li> </ul>
23	streets and fixing potholes in neighborhoods throughout the City to
24	enhance safety and lessen the need for more costly repairs in the future;

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- Reducing Muni crowding and improving Muni reliability by replacing and
   repairing old buses and trains to increase service;
  - Making Muni faster and safer by repairing, modernizing and installing new equipment and facilities to meet the demands of a 21st-Century San Francisco;
  - Improving street safety for all users and reducing conflicts among people
    driving, bicycling and walking by redesigning streets, focusing pedestrian
    safety projects at locations with the highest numbers of injuries and
    fatalities, and expanding and connecting the City's bicycle lanes and
    routes;
  - Creating safer crossings for pedestrians, including seniors and people with disabilities, by installing upgraded traffic signals and pedestrian countdown signals, improving sidewalks and building curb ramps for better accessibility; and,
  - Redesigning key San Francisco streets to make travel safer and easier to navigate.
  - 2. It shall further be the official policy of the City and County of San Francisco that it is appropriate to use the proceeds of the proposed increase in the VLF for these transportation improvements because vehicle owners paying the fee will directly benefit from those improvements through better maintained, safer, and less congested streets.
  - 3. It shall further be the official policy of the City and County of San Francisco that an independent committee track and report on the use of funds generated by the increase in the Vehicle License Fee, and assess whether these funds are being spent consistent with the policy priorities enumerated here.

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4. It shall further be the official policy of the City and County of San Francisco to improve the delivery of reliable and accessible Muni service to neighborhoods with high numbers of low-income households, minority residents, residents with disabilities, seniors, and households without personal automobiles. 5. It shall further be the official policy of the City and County of San Francisco that local decision-makers aggressively pursue other regional, state and federal funds to leverage local funds, so that traffic relief and mobility projects may be delivered more quickly, and so that the City may implement additional needed transportation and transit improvements. 6. This measure is advisory only. By adopting this advisory measure, the voters intend to express their desire that the City use those funds to fund the transportation improvements identified in the declaration. n:\legana\as2014\1400559\00932968.doc
