REQUESTING THAT PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E)

CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY THAT WOULD ASSESS ALTERNATIVE

EMERGENCY POWER SUPPLY MEANS TO VITAL CITY SERVICES, AND/OR

PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

CONCERNING THE OUTAGE AND THE POWER NEEDS OF SAN FRANCISCO.

WHEREAS, On December 8, 1998 the City and County of San Francisco was paralyzed by an extensive power outage; and

WHEREAS, This outage resulted in millions of dollars of losses to both businesses and individuals; and

WHEREAS, Vital City services were disrupted compromising the safety and well-being of residents, visitors and employees in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, Human error was determined to be the cause of this disaster; and WHEREAS, The scope of this blackout is minimal compared to what may occur in the case of a catastrophic seismic event or other natural disaster, and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that the City consider alternative means to power critical City services including San Francisco International Airport, all local Hospitals and public transportation services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco requests that PG&E, as part of it settlement discussions with the City, fund a feasibility study that would consider 1) running a separate power line for Hetch Hetchy power from the East Bay through Alameda and then to San Francisco, via Treasure Island, 2) establishing a separate mini-generator system sited at different facilities, such

as SFO, that would power critical elements of infrastructure during emergencies, 3) restructure City circuits such that power generated from Hunters Point and Potrero Hill substations may be used to power vital City infrastructure if main power lines are disabled; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That, in the alterantive, that the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco request that PG&E provide the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission with any existing studies which may satisfy the request in the aforementioned resolved clause, as well as provide the information previously requested (see attached) in order that they may be better prepared to deal with future emergencies.
