WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institutes of Health (NIH), for a project titled "Aripiprazole to Reduce Methamphetamine Use among MSM with HIV;" and,

WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interest of NIH, PHFE, and DPH to participate in this project; and,

WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse DPH in the amount of \$10,566 under the terms of this agreement for the period of September 28, 2007 through July 31, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds PHFE requires DPH to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 080901, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses the department for one existing position, a Senior Physician Specialist (Job Class 2232) at .05 FTE for the period of September 28, 2007 through July 31, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not receive the required documents from PHFE until May 20, 2008; and,
