RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE SAN FRANCISCO GENERAL HOSPITAL FOUNDATION FOR FUNDRAISING AND CAPITAL PROJECTS

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health (“DPH”) seeks to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) with the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation (“Foundation”) to establish the roles and responsibilities of each party (please see MOU attached) for purposes of fundraising and capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the proposed MOU includes a Capital Project Addendum entitled “The Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital (“ZSFG”) Building 5 Outpatient Health Center Capital Project” (“Project”) intended to fundraise \$200 million for the modernization of ZSFG Building 5; and

WHEREAS, The Project will convert outdated space in Building 5 into state-of-the art outpatient primary and specialty centers of excellence, serving patients and families of all ages, ethnicities and populations in San Francisco; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Health Commission recommends that the Board of Supervisors authorize the Department of Public Health to enter into the MOU and Capital Project Addendum.
