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4 WHEREAS, The voters, by passing Proposition J in 1994, mandated outreach
5 advertising to those communities which may not be adequately served by the official
6 newspaper, pursuant to Sections 2.80 and 2.80-1 of the Administrative Code; and

7 WHEREAS, In each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the outreach
8 periodical for each outreach community, pursuant to Section 2.81-3 of the Administrative
9 Code; and

10 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors may designate neighborhood outreach
11 periodical, pursuant to Section 2.81-4 of the Administrative Code; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the Board designates the following periodicals, which circulate
13 primarily in the indicated communities and are printed in San Francisco, to be the outreach
14 periodicals for the indicated communities for FY2022-2023:
