Resolution declaring October 23, 2013, as Buck Delventhal Day in the City and County of San Francisco in recognition of his receipt of two prestigious awards honoring his contributions in the field of municipal law and his longstanding service and ongoing leadership in the San Francisco City Attorney's Office.

WHEREAS, Burk E. Delventhal, known to all as Buck, joined the San Francisco City Attorney's Office as a Deputy City Attorney on June 17, 1970, and has faithfully served the City and County of San Francisco in that capacity for more than 43 years; and

WHEREAS, The people of San Francisco have benefitted immeasurably from the legal advice and representation that Buck Delventhal has provided to the City over the past 43 years; and


