

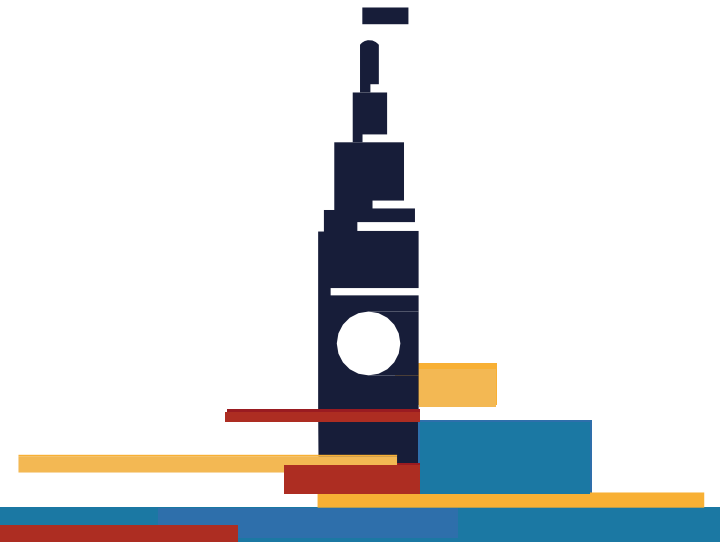

Southern Embarcadero Project Grant Background

- 3 to 7 feet of sea level rise expected by 2100
- California Coastal Conservancy Climate Ready Program award \$7.8 million
- No matching funds required
- No new positions
- No indirect costs
- Total project cost - \$7.8 million



Southern Embarcadero Resilience and Enhancement Project

Scope

- Advance the Port's Waterfront Resilience Program
- Prepare site specific plans and engineering designs
 - Coordinate between four active projects
- Incorporate green-gray infrastructure opportunities
 - Including habitat enhancements
- Improvements to public access amenities between Harrison and Townsend along the Embarcadero



Southern Embarcadero Resilience and Enhancement Project Timeline

- Advertise for proposals: November 2024
- Award contract – January 2025
- Public Realm/ Schematic Design– Winter 2025/26
- Project Completion – Fall 2026
