Transportation Code Modifications: Transit/Parking Violations and Penalties

The SFMTA proposes the following amendments to Division I and Division II of the San Francisco Transportation Code:

- Establish transit violations and penalties for failure to give up a seat to a Senior or Person with Disability and to create a separate category of violations for youth, allowing these to be processed administratively, rather than in the courts.
- Initiate cost recovery fees for the administration of a Transit and Parking Citations Work Credit and Payment Plan program. By payment of this fee, customers would be able to either make installment payments over time or volunteer with approved organizations and City Departments to obtain work credit. During this time, late penalties and special collections fees would not be assessed.
