Re: Minimum Compensation Ordinance and the Mayor's FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25
Proposed Budget

Madam Clerk,

Pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code, SEC 12P.3, the minimum compensation for nonprofit corporations will be \$18.93 as of July 1, 2023, and will be \$20.25 as of July 1, 2024, eventually reaching \$23.00 by January 1, 2026. Pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code, SEC 12P.3, the minimum compensation for public entities will be \$20.25 as of September 1, 2023, and will be \$22.00 by January 1, 2025, eventually reaching 25.50 by July 1, 2027. This letter provides notice to the Board of Supervisors that the Mayor's proposed budget for Fiscal Years (FY) FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25 contains funding to support the full increase in the minimum compensation wage levels for nonprofit corporations and public entities in FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25.
