Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH), to accept and expend a new grant in the amount of \$337,725 from the California Office of Traffic Safety (COTS) to improve pedestrian safety awareness in San Francisco, and to enter into an agreement for the use of these funds; for the period of October 1, 2005, to December 31, 2007.

WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant in the amount of \$337,725 from COTS to improve pedestrian safety in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, COTS requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 051934; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$17,433; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$337,725 from COTS; and, be it


