7 an employee for over 15 years; and,

8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will miss Tony's insight and leadership as  
9 he retires from City service July 1, 2003; and,

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Wagner was the Executive Administrator of Laguna Honda Hospital for 11  
11 years and was Executive Administrator of the Community Health Network for four years; and

12 WHEREAS, Tony testified many times before the Board of Supervisors on a variety of issues  
13 as wide ranging as the annual budget to the replacement plans for both Laguna Honda  
Hospital and San Francisco General Hospital and Medical Center; and

15 insight for many years on improving the healthcare of the community of all San Franciscans;

16 WHEREAS, Anthony Wagner is retiring from City employment at the end of the fiscal year;
