8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

9 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby  
10 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Yulanda Williams v. City and County  
11 of San Francisco et al, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-19-576323, by the  
12 payment of \$625,000. The lawsuit involves an employment dispute.
