[Affirm adoption of the negative declaration for the O'Shaughnessy Dam Discharge Modification Project]

Motion affirming the Planning Commission adoption of the negative declaration for the O'Shaughnessy Dam Discharge Modification Project.

WHEREAS, The project sponsor for the O'Shaughnessy Dam Discharge Modification Project (the "Project") submitted its application for environmental review of the Project on May 8, 2002 (City Planning File No. 2002.0475E); and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Planning Department (the "Department") issued a preliminary mitigated negative declaration for this Project on February 8, 2003, and amended that preliminary mitigated negative declaration on May 1, 2003 (the "negative declaration"). A copy of said document is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. and is incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, On March 10, 2003, the negative declaration was timely appealed to the San Francisco Planning Commission (the "Commission"); and

WHEREAS, On May 1, 2003, the Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on the negative declaration appeal; and

WHEREAS, On said date, the Commission reviewed and considered the preliminary mitigated negative declaration, as amended, the appeal letters, a responses to concerns document that the Department prepared, and public testimony. By Motion No.16573, the Commission found that the contents of the negative declaration and the procedures through which it was prepared, publicized, and reviewed complied with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Cal. Pub. Res. Code sections 21000 et seq., hereinafter "CEQA"),

the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs. Title 14, sections 15000 et seq., ("CEQA Guidelines") and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code ("Chapter 31"); and

WHEREAS, By said Motion No.16573, the Commission found the negative declaration reflected its independent judgment and analysis and was adequate, accurate, and objective, and adopted the negative declaration in compliance with CEQA, the State CEQA Guidelines, and Chapter 31. Said motion is on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No.

WHEREAS, By letter to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors dated May 9, 2003, Ron Good of Restore Hetch Hetchy filed an appeal of the negative declaration to the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, By letter to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors dated May 15, 2003, John Rizzo of the Sierra Club filed an appeal of the negative declaration to the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors received these appeal letters on May 9, and May 15, 2003 respectively; and

WHEREAS, On June 10, 2003, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to consider the appeal of the negative declaration; and

WHEREAS, This Board has reviewed and considered the negative declaration and heard testimony and received public comment regarding the adequacy of this document; and

WHEREAS, The negative declaration files and all correspondence and other documents have been made available for review by this Board, the Commission and the public. These files are available for public review by appointment at the Planning Department offices at 1660 Mission Street, and are part of the record before this Board by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, Since the Planning Commission action on the negative declaration, there is no new information of significance that would require a substantial revision to the negative declaration and necessitate recirculation of said document pursuant to CEQA Guideline section 15073.5; and

WHEREAS, The negative declaration describes the project as consisting of a modification to the piping at O'Shaughnessy Dam that controls discharge to the existing 108-inch Canyon Power Tunnel pipeline (or penstock) at the base of the dam by constructing a new 60-inch pipeline to allow withdrawal of water from a higher level in the reservoir, to be used when turbidity in the reservoir is above the allowable level and to increase the reliability of the existing outletand reduce head loss; and

WHEREAS, The negative declaration further describes the project as not increasing the capacity of the existing Hetch Hetchy Reservoir or discharge volumes and does not describe the project as potentially reducing spills from the O'Shaughnessy Dam or as diverting water from the Tuolumne River between the Hetch Hetchy Reservoir and the Kirkwood Powerhouse; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department's June 5, 2003 memorandum to the Board of Supervisors describes the potential capacity of the proposed 60-inch and existing 108-inch pipelines to divert an additional 40 cubic feet per second of water from the Hetch Hetchy Reservoir if both pipes are fully opened during abundant water conditions, but the negative declaration does not describe the project as including such a potential operation of the proposed and existing pipelines; and

WHEREAS, The project sponsor has indicated that it intends to restrict the diversion of water at O'Shaugnessy Dam to the Canyon Power Tunnel through use of the existing 108-inch outlet at the bottom of the reservoir and only to use the new higher elevation 60-inch

outlet in the event of water quality problems or to the extent that the existing 108-inch outlet cannot be used due to an unforseen event or required maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Any change in any level of spill from the O'Shaughnessy Dam or diversion of water from the Tuolumne River between the Hetch Hetchy Reservoir and the Kirkwood Powerhouse as a result of the simultaneous operation of both the proposed 60-inch pipeline and the existing 108-inch pipeline would require additional environmental review in compliance with CEQA; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That based on substantial evidence in light of the whole record, this Board of Supervisors finds the negative declaration for the project as described herein reflects its independent judgment and analysis and is adequate, accurate, and objective, and hereby affirms the decision of the Planning Commission in its Motion No. 16573 to adopt the negative declaration in compliance with CEQA, the State CEQA Guidelines, and Chapter 31: and

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors finds that any change in any level of spill from the O'Shaughnessy Dam or diversion of water from the Tuolumne River between the Hetch Hetchy Reservoir and the Kirkwood Powerhouse as a result of the simultaneous operation of both the proposed 60-inch pipeline and the existing 108-inch pipeline would require additional environmental review in compliance with CEQA.
