On December 20, 2017 the San Francisco Historic Preservation Commission (hereinafter "HPC") conducted a duly noticed public hearing at a regularly scheduled meeting to consider a recommendation for landmark designation of the wall at the intersection of Diamond Heights Boulevard and Clipper Street, known historically as the Diamond Heights Safety Wall, to the Board of Supervisors. At the hearing, the HPC voted to **approve** a resolution to recommend landmark designation pursuant to Article 10 of the Planning Code.

The proposed amendments have been determined to be categorically exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act Section 15060(c)(2).
