1	[Urging the University of California San Francisco to reduce its energy consumption through a
2	reduction of night lighting]
3	
4	Resolution urging the University of California San Francisco to reduce its energy
5	consumption by 10% over the next two years, in part through a reduction of night
6	lighting on its campuses.
7	
8	WHEREAS, Energy consumption contributes directly to the production of greenhouse
9	gases that cause climate change by heating the Earth's atmosphere; and
10	WHEREAS, The specter of global climate crisis, energy shortages, and rising sea
11	levels affect the entire earth, including San Francisco, a city with three-fourths of its perimeter
12	surrounded by water from the Pacific Ocean and San Francisco Bay; and
13	WHEREAS, The University of California San Francisco (UCSF) is the largest employer
14	in the City and County of San Francisco; and,
15	WHEREAS, UCSF is a recognized leader in the health of San Francisco citizens and
16	all of mankind; and
17	WHEREAS, UCSF is committed to promoting the highest ethical and environmental
18	standards; and
19	WHEREAS, UCSF serves as a natural leader and model for the San Francisco
20	community; and
21	WHEREAS, The loss of dark nights and starry skies due to street lights has a negative
22	aesthetic affect on humans and other animals; and
23	WHEREAS, Scientific evidence shows that nightlights often do not inhibit crime,
24	according to numerous studies, including those by the School of Criminal Justice at Rutgers
25	University; and

1	WHEREAS, Numerous school districts have saved energy costs while reducing
2	vandalism by darkening their campuses, including the Spokane School District, the Riverside
3	School District, and the Cupertino Union School District; and
4	WHEREAS, A recent startling research report suggests that nightlight may play a
5	stimulatory role in environment-associated breast cancer; now, therefore, be it
6	RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges UCSF to begin a
7	program to reduce its energy consumption by 10% over the next two years; and, be it
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges UCSF to
9	accomplish this reduction in part by a reduction of night lighting on its campuses.
