3 **Resolution to extend the Asthma Task Force to June 30, 2005.**

5 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Asthma Task Force was to complete a strategic plan  
6 with recommendations for legislative action and city-wide strategies to manage and prevent  
7 asthma in the City and County of San Francisco; and,

8 WHEREAS, the Asthma Task Force is about to embark on the second phase of its  
9 duties, to advocate for and monitor the implementation of its recommendations and report  
10 back on progress to the Board of Supervisors every six months; and,

11 WHEREAS, the Asthma Task Force garnered recognition and support for its work with  
12 a three year \$450,000 grant from the California Endowment on March 1, 2002 which the  
13 American Lung Association helped to secure on behalf of the Asthma Task Force; and,

14 WHEREAS, the Asthma Task Force needs additional time to complete its duties of  
15 advocating for and monitoring implementation of its recommendations; and,

16 WHEREAS, the Asthma Task Force wishes to take full advantage of the opportunities  
17 provided by the grant from the California Endowment; and,

18 WHEREAS, an extension of the Task Force will help to ensure that key aspects of the  
19 plan are implemented to address the needs of families, communities, institutions, and the city  
20 with regards to asthma management and prevention; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
22 hereby extends the term of the San Francisco Asthma Task Force and all of its appointed  
23 members from June 30, 2003 to June 30, 2005.
