WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services intends to use EHAP capital development funding to install a hydraulic elevator, install heating on the first and second floors, construct two new showers per each two floors, replace the water heater and install insulation on the first two floors, and make other necessary repairs; and,

WHEREAS, these repairs and improvements are necessary in order to convert the building from a storage site to an emergency over-flow homeless shelter; and

WHEREAS, the EHAP load will be forgiven if the site continues to be used as a shelter for homeless persons for the next seven years; and

WHEREAS, the Department proposes to maximize use of available loan funds for expenditures related to site improvement by not including indirect costs in the project budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Human Services Commission authorized the application for this EHAP deferred loan at its meeting of March 27, 2003; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the acceptance of the forgivable loan authorized by this Resolution is approved, the Department of Human Services hereby agrees to use the EHAP
