3 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has always been committed to maintaining
4 excellent standards of air quality; and,

5 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco encourages and promotes the use of public
6 transportation through its Transit First Policy; and,

7 WHEREAS, The City provides various alternatives to driving with its Muni, Bart and Cable car
8 services; and,

9 WHEREAS, One of the goals of the City's Transit First Policy is to make public transit systems
10 an attractive alternative to travel by car; and,

11 WHEREAS, The California Air Resources Board states that reducing motor vehicle use is one
12 of the best prevention and control methods of air pollutants in California; and

13 WHEREAS, Automobiles are the largest source of air pollution in the Bay Area, producing over
14 six million pounds of vehicle emissions every day; and,

15 WHEREAS, Automobiles can also pollute the water, as run-off from highways and roads enter
16 and subsequently pollute our water systems; and,

17 WHEREAS, The goal of California Rideshare Week is for people to carpool, bus, or ferry just
18 once during the week; and,

19 WHEREAS, California Rideshare Week's objective, to encourage ridesharing and alternate
20 forms of transportation, supports the goals of San Francisco's Transit First Policy; now, therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, That the City and County of San Francisco does hereby recognize October 4-8 as
22 California Rideshare Week.
