

1 [Accept-Expend State Tire Recycling Grant]
2 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT
3 AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00 FROM THE CALIFORNIA
4 INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD (CIWMB) FOR THE INSTALLATION OF
5 RUBBER MATTING MADE FROM RECYCLED CALIFORNIA TIRES IN DUBOCE PARK.

6 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the City and County of
7 San Francisco to promote waste prevention, reuse and recycling
8 throughout the City and to reduce the amount of material that is
9 landfilled; and,

10 WHEREAS, The people of the State of California have enacted
11 Assembly Bill 1843 (W. Brown, Chapter 974, Statutes of 1989) that
12 provides grants to local governments for the purpose of diverting
13 tires from landfill disposal and for recycling used tires by
14 fostering new business enterprises for such purpose; and,

15 WHEREAS, The California Integrated Waste Management Board has
16 been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the
17 program within the State of California, and grant funds are available
18 from the CIWMB; and,


19 WHEREAS, The CIWMB does not allow use of grant funds on indirect
20 costs; now, therefore be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the
22 General Manager of the Recreation and Park Department to accept and
23 expend, a tire recycling grant of up to \$25,000.00 from the
24 California Integrated Waste Management Board to fund projects
25 relating to the installation of rubber matting from recycled


1 California tires in Duboce Park located in the City and County of San
2 Francisco; and be it


3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives

8 Francisco, all applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and
9 payment requests necessary for the purpose of securing such tire
10 recycling grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes
11 specified in the applicable grant application.




