4 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Recreation and Parks to retroactively accept**
5 **and expend a grant valued at \$116,000 from the San Francisco Conservation Corps to**
6 **rebuild community garden plot terraces at Wolfe Lane Community Garden.**

8 WHEREAS, The City owns real property located at 50 Rutledge on Block 5535, Lots
9 011-016, and Block 5557, Lots 16 & 17, known as the Mullen Ave Realignment on which
10 Wolfe Lane Community Garden ("the Community Garden") is situated; and

11 WHEREAS, The Community Garden is located on property under the jurisdiction of
12 the Department of Public Works. However the Community Garden is managed under the
13 Recreation and Park Department's Community Gardens Program; and

14 WHEREAS, The Community Garden is comprised of garden plot terraces which are in
15 deteriorating condition; and

16 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Conservation Corps ("SFCC") received grant funding
17 from the State Proposition 84 Water Bond Act of 2006 for public safety/erosion control
18 projects ("State Grant"); and

19 WHEREAS, SFCC is proposing to rebuild the garden plot terraces of the Community
20 Garden through State Grant; and

21 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

22 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; and


23 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission recommends to the Board of



The San Francisco Conservation Corps (SFCC) has submitted a grant to the California Conservation Corps (CCC), who serves as the fiscal agent for local corps funding allocation through Proposition 84 Water Bond Act of 2006, to implement an erosion control project on your properties, Wolfe Lane in the amount of \$116,000.

SFCC anticipates receiving a contract in January 2012, which will allow SFCC to remove the wood rot timbers, soil and weeds and to install new erosion control retaining walls, steps, landscape fabric and soil.

SFCC is pleased to be partnering with San Francisco Recreation and Park on another project, which allows SFCC Corpsmembers (CMS) to gain technical skills while simultaneously, improving the community and its residents.
