SUPPORTING AB 107 WHICH PROVIDES EMPLOYERS THE ABILITY TO OFFER HEALTH CARE COVERAGE TO DOMESTIC PARTNERS OF THEIR EMPLOYEES AND ANNUITANTS.

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 107, introduced by Assembly Member Knox, would provide government agencies that participate in the existing Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) the ability to offer health care coverage to the domestic partners of their employees and annuitants; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 107 would authorize state and local government employers to elect to include within the definition of "family member," domestic partners (as defined by the AB 107) who have submitted certificates of eligibility to the Board of Administration of PERS; and,

WHEREAS, After adoption by the State legislature, this proposed article would become applicable to state-employed members of the Public Employees' Retirement System only if the Governor issues an executive order or if every state bargaining unit has signed a memorandum of understanding to become subject to this article; and,

WHEREAS, Governor Gray Davis has stated that he would support a bill extending health benefits to domestic partners; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco supports AB 107 and urges its passage by the State legislature; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges Governor Davis to issue an executive order authorizing coverage under this article.
