24 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

25 Section 1. Environmental Findings.

The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources

1 Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
2 Supervisors in File No. ____ and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms this
3 determination.

5 Section 2. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Section 94B.4, to
6 read as follows:

7 **SEC. 94B.2. ENTERTAINMENT ZONE CONTROLS.**

8 * * * *

9 (c) All open alcoholic beverages consumed during an Entertainment Zone Event shall
10 be purchased only from a premises located within the Entertainment Zone that is authorized
11 under California Business and Professions Code Section 23357, 23358, or 23396, as may be
12 amended from time to time, to permit consumers to leave the premises with open containers
13 of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises, or an organization that is authorized
14 by an ABC special event permit or license to make such sales within the Entertainment Zone.

21 (A) All public streets, public rights-of-way, and sidewalks abutting both
22 sides of Folsom Street, between ~~7th~~12th Street and ~~8th~~Russ Street; both sides of Hallam
23 Street, between Folsom Street and Brush Place; ~~and~~ both sides of Langton Street, between
24 Folsom Street and Decker Alley; both sides of Russ Street, between Minna and Folsom Streets;
25 both sides of 7th Street between Folsom and Harrison Streets; both sides of 8th Street between Folsom

1 and Harrison Streets; both sides of Harrison Street between 7th and 13th Streets; both sides of 12th
2 Street between Harrison and Folsom Streets; both sides of 11th Street between Harrison and Folsom
3 Streets; both sides of 10th Street between Harrison and Howard Streets; both sides of Howard Street
4 between 10th and 11th Streets; both sides of Dore Street between Folsom and Sheridan Streets; both

7 specified in Section 94B.2(c) that are adjacent thereto, are hereby designated as the *Folsom*
8 ~~Street~~West SoMa Entertainment Zone under Sections 23039.5 and 25690 of the California
9 Business and Professions Code.

10 (B) Notwithstanding subsection (c), if an Entertainment Zone Event
11 within the *Folsom* ~~Street~~West SoMa Entertainment Zone does not involve the closure of a public
12 street, it need not receive a permit for the use of a public street under Transportation Code
13 Division I, Section 6.6 or 6.16 or Transportation Code Division II, Section 206, or other
14 applicable authority of the SFMTA.

17 Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
18 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
19 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
20 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
21 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the “Note” that appears under
22 the official title of the ordinance.

23
24 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
25 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

1 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
2 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

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LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - West SoMa Entertainment Zone]

Existing Law

Under Administrative Code Chapter 94B, open alcoholic beverages can be consumed on any public street, avenue, sidewalk, stairway, alley, or thoroughfare within an Entertainment Zone during an Entertainment Zone Event, subject to state and local law, when those beverages are purchased from a licensed premises within the Entertainment Zone.

Administrative Code Section 94B.1 defines an Entertainment Zone Event as “an event that occurs within the boundaries of an Entertainment Zone established in accordance with this Chapter 94B and within the hours permitted by this Chapter 94B and the Management Plan or the Downtown Activation Permit issued pursuant to Administrative Code Chapter 94D for the Entertainment Zone.” Administrative Code Section 94B.4 establishes Entertainment Zone locations.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would eliminate the Folsom Street Entertainment Zone and create the West SoMa Entertainment Zone, to include the following streets: Folsom Street, between 12th and Russ Streets; Hallam Street, between Folsom Street and Brush Place; Langton Street, between Folsom Street and Decker Alley; Russ Street, between Minna and Folsom Streets; 7th Street between Folsom and Harrison Streets; 8th Street between Folsom and Harrison Streets; Harrison Street between 7th and 13th Streets; 12th Street between Harrison and Folsom Streets; 11th Street between Harrison and Folsom Streets; 10th Street between Harrison and Howard Streets; Howard Street between 10th and 11th Streets; Dore Street between Folsom and Sheridan Streets; 9th Street between Harrison and Folsom Streets;
