3 **Ordinance amending Chapter 2 of Article III of the Campaign and Governmental**
4 **Conduct Code to prohibit members of City boards and commissions from obtaining**
5 **employment with the City during their tenure and for one year after the termination of**
6 **their City service.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby
12 amended by adding Section 3.235, to read as follows:

13 SEC. 3.235. CITY EMPLOYMENT FOR MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

14 (a) For the purposes of this Section, the term "board or commission" means an appointed
15 board or commission created by Charter or ordinance of the City and County whose members are
16 required by Article III, Chapter 1 of this Code to file statements of economic interests.

17 (b) During his or her service and for a period of one year after the last day of his or her
18 service, no member of a board or commission shall be eligible for appointment to any full time,
19 compensated employment with the City and County. This restriction shall not prohibit a member of a
20 board or commission from being elected to an office of the City and County, appointed to fill a vacancy
21 in an elective office of the City and County, or appointed to another board or commission.

22 (c) Nothing in this Section is intended to interfere with or abridge any rights held by any
23 employee or former employee of the City and County of San Francisco pursuant to Civil Service Rules.
