Resolution appointing Linda M. Yu Bien (residency requirement waived), term ending January 15, 2007 to the San Francisco Health Authority.

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the San Francisco Health Authority, pursuant to the provisions in the Welfare and Institutions Code Sec. 14087.36 and the San Francisco Administrative Code Sections 69.1 et seq., for the term specified:

Linda M. Yu Bien (residency waiver required), succeeding Sophie Wong, term expired, Seat No. 6, must be an employee in the senior management of either private nonprofit community clinics or a community clinic consortium, nominated by the SF Community Clinic Consortium or any successor organization for a 3-year term ending January 15, 2007.
