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3	Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend
4	\$86,520 in federal Section 5303 Technical Study funding to develop and produce the FY
5	2008 Short Range Transit Plan.
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7	WHEREAS, The Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make monies available
8	under the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for mass transportation
9	projects; and
10	WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA), City and County of San
11	Francisco is an eligible claimant for FTA Technical Study planning assistance grants under
12	Section 5303 of TEA-21; and
13	WHEREAS, Section 5303 funds may be used for transit service and capital planning
14	activities; and
15	WHEREAS, The grant contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations
16	on the applicant, including providing the local share (\$11,480) of project costs; and
17	WHEREAS, The local share of project costs will be provided separately as in-kind
18	services from the MTA, primarily through staff time, funding for which is contained in Muni's
19	FY07 and FY08 operating budgets; and
20	WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) requires the San
21	Francisco Municipal Railway (Muni) to produce a Short Range Transit Plan (SRTP) every four
22	years; and
23	WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA) Board of Directors adopted
24	Muni's last SRTP in December 2005; and
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1	WHEREAS, The Executive Director/CEO of the MTA (or his designee) must execute		
2	agreements to complete transfer of the funds; and		
3	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and		
4	WHEREAS, There is no allowance for indirect costs; now, therefore, be it		
5	RESOLVED, That on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the MTA is		
6	authorized to accept and expend \$86,520 in federal Section 5303 Technical Study Grant		
7	planning assistance to develop and produce the FY2008 Short Range Transit Plan; and, be it		
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of indirect		
9	costs in the grant budget; and, be it		
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional		
11	information or assurances may be requested by the funding agencies in connection with this		
12	request; and, be it		
13	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to execute any and all agreements		
14	necessary to complete transfer of the funds.
