3 **Ordinance amending the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code to update and**  
4 **clarify the Conflict of Interest Code’s Form 700 (Statement of Economic Interests) filing**  
5 **requirements for “Proposition Q Filers” (Departmental Purchaser Initiators and**  
6 **Approvers); add the Children and Families First Commission to the list of filers who file**  
7 **with the Ethics Commission; and make non-substantive corrections to the Conflict of**  
8 **Interest Code sections for the Department of Public Works and the Public Utilities**  
9 **Commission.**

17 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

18 Section 1. Article III, Chapter 1 of the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is  
19 hereby amended by revising Sections 3.1-103, 3.1-365, 3.1-370; and adding new Section 3.1-  
20 109, to read as follows:

21 **SEC. 3.1-103. FILING OFFICERS.**

22 Persons holding designated positions shall file the specified statements, declarations,  
23 and certificates with the filing officers designated in this Section 3.1-103.

9 **SEC. 3.1-109. ~~REPEALED-DELEGATED DEPARTMENTAL PURCHASER (PROP Q)~~**  
10 **INITIATORS AND APPROVERS.**

11 Disclosure Category Q. Unless otherwise specified in this Chapter 1, Persons designated by  
12 their department as a Delegated Departmental Purchase Initiator or Approver under Proposition Q  
13 (November 1993) (“Prop Q”) shall disclose all investments and business positions in any business  
14 entity, as well as income or gifts received from any business entity, which does business subject to Prop  
15 Q with the Person’s department, or has done business subject to Prop Q with the Person’s department  
16 within the reporting period covered by the disclosure statement.

21 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after  
22 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the  
23 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board  
24 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.  
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Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the “Note” that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
