WHEREAS, The law firm of Milberg, Weiss, Bershad, Hynes & Lerach, LLP, has considerable experience in this type of litigation, having previously represented various public entities, including the City and County of San Francisco, in successful litigation against the tobacco industry and having previously filed suit against the major electricity generators on behalf of private parties; and

WHEREAS, Milberg, Weiss, Bershad, Hynes & Lerach, LLP may also be retained to represent other California public entities in litigation relating to the electricity crisis; and

WHEREAS, The City Attorney has approved the retainer of Milberg, Weiss, Bershad,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Attorney is required to provide periodic reports on the status of this litigation to the Board of Supervisors; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Attorney is required to provide a quarterly accounting of all revenues and expenditures in the Affirmative Litigation Fund to the Board of Supervisors.
